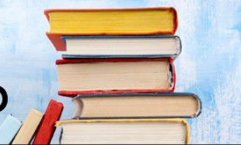

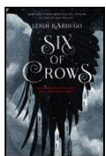


Teen Book Club

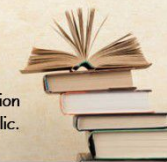

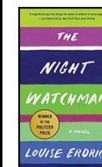

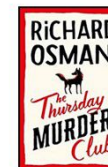
