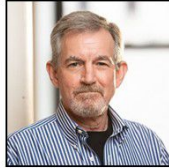

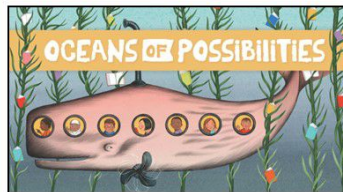
A Conversation with Maine Author Spencer Stephens

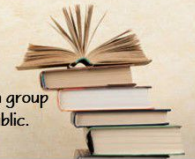
