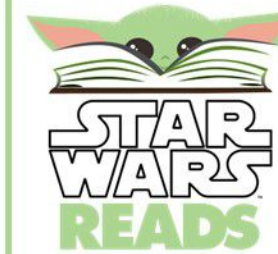
Songs, fingerplays, and a story for children and their caregivers. Watch the recorded versions posted for 24 hours on our Facebook and YouTube playlists.
